The Commission is seeking input from the public regarding the proposals in the FLUM which, once approved by City Council, will be the basis for land use decisions and possible zoning changes over the next 5 to 10 years. Staff will provide a presentation of the FLUM and the Commission will open the meeting for questions and comments from the public.
