Welcome to Horseshoe Bay! My guiding principal as Mayor is to preserve the lifestyle and ambiance above all other interests with minimal City taxes and expenses. Earlier this year the Council adopted as our first Mission Statement: "To serve and protect our citizens while preserving our heritage and planning our future"



Horseshoe Bay was incorporated in 2005 and is made up of several separate subdivisions with their own architectural control committees to preserve their respective culture. We are very proud of our amenities including five golf courses and a constant level lake providing year round activities for our residents and visitors alike, but the best reason for living in Horseshoe Bay is the people.

Our community has approximately 6500 full and part-time residents. The building permits last year surpassed each of the previous six years and we are on track to exceed 2014 with continued controlled growth. Our council held the property tax rate at 25 cents per \$100 valuation, the same as it has been for the past three years.

Our community has high expectations and standards for the city staff and leaders. We have recently formed a Long Range Planning Committee and Communications Committee made up of residents to plan for and address these issues.
