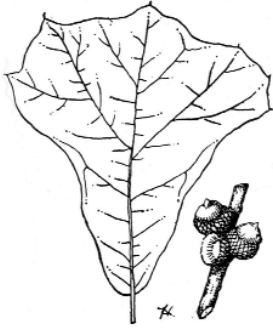

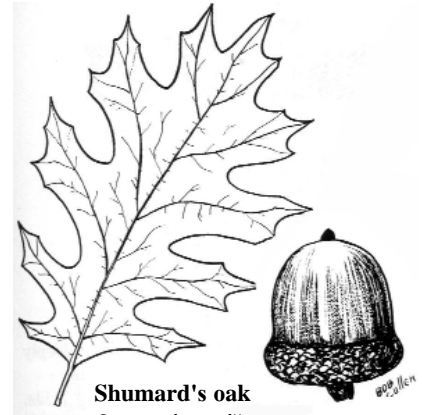
Red Oak group *

(East Texas native)

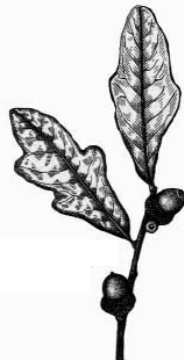
(* Red oaks infected with oak wilt can form fungal mats.)

White Oak group (more resistant to oak wilt)



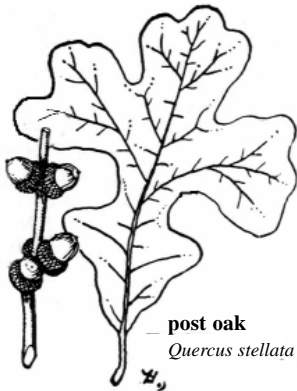

breviloba



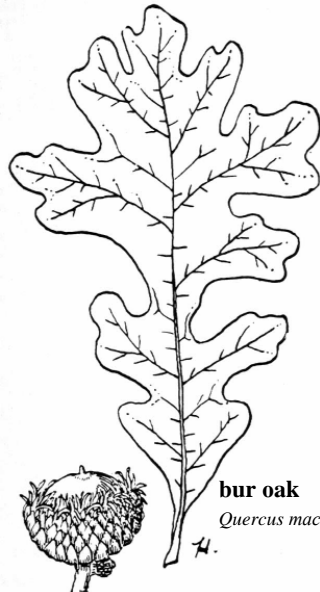
Lacey oak

Quercus muehlenbergii



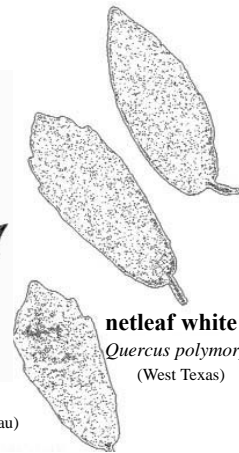
post oak
