

**CITY OF HORSESHOE BAY**  
**CITY COUNCIL WORKSHOP**

**MINUTES**

October 19, 2009

The Council of the City of Horseshoe Bay held a Special Public Meeting to conduct a Streets Workshop at City Hall, located at #1 Community Drive, Horseshoe Bay, Llano County, Texas, October 19, 2009, in accordance with duly posted notice of said meeting. Mayor Bob Lambert called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m. with a quorum of Council Members present as follows:

The posted agenda for this meeting is made a part of these minutes by attachment and the minutes are herewith recorded in the order the agenda items were considered with the agenda subject and item number shown preceding the applicable paragraph.

1. Call to Order and Establish a Quorum: Mayor Bob Lambert called the streets workshop to order at 3:00 p.m. with a quorum present.
  
2. Streets Workshop: Mayor Lambert stated that during all deliberations and discussions about using assessments the Council maintained they would only be done if residents wanted the streets upgraded and were willing to pay for it. This does not seem to be the case with residents of The Fairways. Councilperson Spence made the motion to no longer proceed with plans for a street upgrade of The Fairways. The motion was seconded by Councilperson Haydon. The motion passed unanimously (5-0).

The Council discussed concentrating on possible upgrades on major boulevards and arterial roads and various ways these could be paid for. The Council asked City Manager Stan Farmer to work on a plan for normal chip sealing and maintenance of City Streets.

A Streets workshop was called for December 14, 2009 at 3:00 p.m.

3. Adjournment: Councilperson Robinson made the motion to adjourn the meeting at 4:06 p.m. The motion was seconded by Councilperson Haydon. The motion passed unanimously (5-0).
