

HSB Council Considers Renaming Portion of Mountain Dew Street

Many of us have experienced to confusion of being at the corner of Mountain Dew and Mountain Dew in Horseshoe Bay South. Imagine the problem this can cause if you are a first responder rushing to aid a citizen in immediate need of Police, Fire or EMS. The Horseshoe Bay City Council is considering renaming a portion of Mountain Dew, Great Western and Buzzard Roost to make it easier for everyone using these streets.

Under consideration is a plan to rename portions of these streets as follows:

First, continue Thanksgiving Mountain across Hi Ridge replacing one of the two Great Western streets until it intersects with the existing Mountain Dew. There are no houses located on this Great Western.

Second, the existing Mountain Dew will be cut in half and only run from Clayton Nolan till it meets Buzzard Roost, where it will go straight and replace the existing Buzzard Roost until it ends at the portion of Mountain Dew to be renamed. Buzzard Roost will go away.

Third, that approximate half of Mountain Dew remaining will be renamed with input from the citizens of Horseshoe Bay. That is the portion from the southern existing intersection of Buzzard Roost and Mountain Dew until the point where it currently intersects with itself at the corner of Mountain Dew and Mountain Dew. The changes under consideration will only impact five existing homes on the portion of Mountain Dew that would be renamed. The City plans to coordinate with Burnet County 911 relative to any street renaming.
