The City of Horseshoe Bay has entered into a public Private Partnership with HSB Park, Inc. a corporation formed for the purpose of developing and managing a Nature Park located at 1514 Golden Nugget. Plans are underway with the expectation for having a Master Plan completed in the late Fall with implementation to follow.

The City of HSB has committed through a Cooperation Agreement to appropriate limited funds, with the majority of the support provided from individual donors, foundations, community partners or grantors. A 501c3 tax exemption has been obtained from the IRS.
