Llano County has been selected by the State of Texas to serve as a COVID-19 vaccine provider. Beginning April 8, 2021, working with state agencies and the Texas National Guard we will begin distributing 800 to 1000 doses daily by appointment. As a State-designated COVID-19 vaccine distribution hub, Llano County invites all members of the community to register for the opportunity to receive the COVID-19 vaccine at a Llano County vaccination clinic.

“Llano County being selected as a HUB Vaccine provider for the state of Texas is a true testament to the hard work our Local Health Authority and our Office of Emergency Management have done over the last year,” said County Judge Ron Cunningham. “Our primary objective is to provide vaccine to those who wish to receive it, regardless if they are Llano County residents or not. We believe this is the quickest way to stop the pandemic locally and to save lives and the suffering of those who contract the virus.”

On Thursday April 8, 2021 and Friday April 9, 2021 Llano County and the Texas Division of Emergency Management will have a vaccine clinic by appointment only

- **When**-8:00 AM to 5:00 PM
- **Type of Vaccine**-Johnson & Johnson (1 shot)
- **Amount**-800 doses per day
- **Who can receive the vaccine?** Anyone 18 years of age and older
