COVID-19 Vaccine Update

June 1, 2021

Outbreak update

As of 5/27 reporting by TDSHS there are 117 active COVID-19 cases in Blanco, Burnet, Gillespie, Llano, Mason and San Saba Counties. That is down just 9 from last week. 11,010 residents have had test-confirmed cases of COVID 19. 215 have perished with COVID-19 as the primary reason.

The CDC relaxed masking rules for **fully vaccinated citizens**. There are still over 23,400 residents in the four counties not vaccinated, or recovered, from COVID-19. As you can see the cases are dropping over time, but still hanging on as summer gatherings continue to fuel the outbreak. Graduations and Memorial Day weekend gatherings will spread some infections.


First Doses the week of 6/1

The number of residents seeking first doses has **dropped significantly** in the last few weeks. We see that in the State data, and on the Marble Falls Hospital campus. We have a handful of first dose appointments this week and over 100 second doses. Marble Falls Hospital hub is operating one day per week on Thursdays only through the end of June.

Vaccinations

Vaccination continues in our area at a slower pace. As of 6/1/2021, 38% of the 12+ population is fully vaccinated. To get to 80% of the population over age 12 vaccinated or recovered, we have **8,000 more** doses to go for Blanco, Burnet, Llano and San Saba Counties.

Marble Falls Hub

- 32,000 doses have been given since the Hub opened.
- Walk ins are welcome on Thursdays
- MFISD, Atkins Pharmacy, Highland Lakes Crisis Ministry, the Marble Falls EOC, and BSWH held the second outreach vaccination clinic Saturday, May 29th, for underrepresented populations. 100 doses were given. Very well received.
- We cannot emphasize enough caution in this transition time as we are still seeing a number COVID-19 infected residents sick enough to be hospitalized.
