



**Proclamation of the City of Horseshoe Bay
Declaring September 24 – September 30, 2023
as “Source Water Protection Week”**

- WHEREAS,** the health, prosperity, and quality of life of the City of Horseshoe Bay’s citizens and communities depend on a reliable supply of safe, high quality drinking water;
- WHEREAS,** protecting our drinking water is essential to preserve our own health and economy and that of future generations;
- WHEREAS,** we strive to build opportunities and work together to ensure clean, safe source water for all;
- WHEREAS,** all Horseshoe Bay residents and visitors are encouraged to recognize this precious resource and help conserve the watersheds that are the source of our water, protect our shared water resources from pollution, practice water conservation, become involved in local water issues, and plan to protect water for future community health and economic vitality.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED by the City Council of the City of Horseshoe Bay, Texas:

September 24 – September 30, 2023 “Source Water Protection Week”

1. September 24 – September 30, 2023 shall hereafter be known as “Source Water Protection Week” in Horseshoe Bay, Texas.
2. The City calls upon the citizens of Horseshoe Bay to recognize this week by recognizing their responsibility for ensuring our drinking water source for Horseshoe Bay communities are not polluted by personal activities.
3. Support the City’s Source Water Protection efforts to ensure preservation of our drinking water source for now and for future generations.
4. The City Secretary is hereby instructed to post this Proclamation for public display and enter this document into the records of the municipality.
